

Jewel Motor Park Information

What: Family oriented private motor park with six (6) miles of trails, Moto-Cross course and 525 acres of free range hill and valley riding. It has a kid tract, mud holes, walking trails, picnic areas, dirt biking and horse riding areas.

Members obtain year around access by joining the Motor Club. Applications will be available at the Grand Opening.

The park has beautiful hidden hills and valleys and scenic views of the Yellowstone River. It has diverse topography ranging from level land, moderate and steep hills.

Where: The Motor Park is located eight (8) miles northeast of Miles City with the entrance at the old Wild Horse Saloon site by state highway 10. The Kiddie Course is located between highway 10 and Interstate 94.

Who: The Jewel Motor Club was organized by Paul Wilkinson-President, Ryan Dittus-Vice President and Butch Krutzfeldt-Agent for Camp 21, LLC. These organizers together with some of their friends have worked many hours providing equipment and dollars to build the park. The goals of organizers is to provide a first class motor park.

When: A grand showing of the project area is September 22 and 23, 2018 at 10 am to 6 pm. Please come, enjoy a free lunch, obtain information and get a viewing of the project.

Why: There are many four wheelers, motorcycles, bicycles, motorized vehicles and horse riders that need a place to go near Miles City.
