***Senior Citizen Volunteer** – Any retired person, not connected with a business or profession, who has made significant contributions to a business, profession, or organization in Southeastern Montana.

***Volunteer** – Any individual (not retired) who has made a significant (non-compensated) contribution to an organization or group in Southeastern Montana.

***Harvey Wolke Award** – This award is not an annual award but instead, is presented only when an individual or group is cited for outstanding community betterment, civic vision, and the ability to motivate and guide the community in these efforts. Monetary self-gain or the opportunity for future self-gain cannot be an issue.

Please submit your nominations by January 4, 2016. A committee has been designated make the selections from the entries. The nominees will then be invited to the Chamber’s Annual Banquet on Thursday, January 21, 2016.
