What is Mental Health First Aid?

Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) is a public education program designed to help the general public identify, understand and respond to signs of mental illness and substance abuse disorders. MHFA is managed, operated, and disseminated by three national authorities – the National Council for Behavioral Healthcare, the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, and the Missouri Department of Mental Health.

An interactive 8-hour course presents an overview of mental illness and substance abuse disorders and introduces participants to risk factors and warning signs of mental health problems and builds understanding of their impact. Upon completion of the 8-hour course participants become certified as a Mental Health First Aider after learning the MHFA five-step action plan encompassing the skills, resources, and knowledge to assist an individual in crisis to connect with appropriate professional, peer, social, and self-help care.

BECOME A MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AIDER

The MHFA 8-hour training course teaches people how to give first aid to individuals experiencing a mental health crisis situation and/or who are in the early stages of a mental health disorder. Participants will learn the signs and symptoms of the most common mental health problems, where and when to get help, and what type of help has been shown to be effective. Mental Health problems covered are depression, anxiety disorders, schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, eating disorders, substance use disorders, and self-injury.

Crisis situations covered include suicidal behaviors, acute stress reaction after a trauma, panic attack, acute psychotic behavior, and drug overdose.

This class will be worth 8 credit hours of continuing ed. for LCSWs, LCPCs, LACs, MFTs.

Participants learn to use the MHFA Action Plan to:

- Assess risk of suicide or harm
- Listen nonjudgmentally
- Give reassurance and information
- Encourage the person to get appropriate professional help
- Encourage self-help and other support strategies from peers, family, and friends

Who participates in MHFA?

The 8-hour MHFA training course has benefitted a variety of audiences including primary care professionals, nursing home staff, mental health services consumers, family members, employers and business leaders, victim advocates, faith communities, school personnel and educators, state police and corrections officers, state policymakers, welfare workers, case managers, substance abuse counselors, mental health services providers, social workers, mental health authorities, volunteers, young people, and the general public.

The MHFA course is designed to increase mental health literacy, to decrease stigmatizing attitudes in our communities and to increase appropriate and early help-seeking by people suffering from mental health disorders. Certified MHFA instructors deliver the 8-hour course.

The Miles City Local Advisory Council on Mental Health

The Miles City LAC was formed in 2007 and is a coalition of community members interested in assessing, planning and strengthening public mental health services in Miles City and to provide input and recommendations to governing entities.

What this means for your community is that those impacted by the effects of mental illness can ensure that their voice, suggestions, and ideas can make a difference in how services are planned and provided. All those concerned and interested in how persons with mental illness are treated and helped to achieve independence are invited to participate.

Miles City Downtown Urban Renewal (TIF) District Façade Improvement Grant Program Guidelines

MILES CITY DOWNTOWN (TIFD) FAÇADE GRANT - OPEN APRIL 1, 2016

The TIF District will be launching the MC Downtown Façade Grant April 1st. We were looking for an affordable way we could thank – and help downtown business owners that have been so supportive throughout the process of establishing our new TIF District. The storefronts on Main and the downtown side streets and along 7th Street are a visitor's first impression – and we have some wonderful facades in Miles City. They create a visually attractive and vibrant downtown ambiance that welcomes visitors and shoppers alike to downtown Miles City. This is a great opportunity for business owners who want to spiff things up a little before BHS and the summer season gets underway!

The Grant is made possible with funding from the Montana Main Street Program and the City; and allocates \$12,000 for qualified projects while funds are available. Applications will be reviewed in the order received and awards based on readiness for the proposed project to proceed.

The goal of the FIG program is to make revitalization efforts affordable by providing matching grant funds of up to \$2000. The TIFD Board reserves the right to consider grants in larger amounts based on the merits of the proposed project. A 1:1 match is required, i.e., applicants must match the amount of the grant with an equal or greater investment.

Eligible Applicants: TIF District Business owners that own or lease their business location.

Eligible projects include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Store signage (rehabilitating existing signage, including historic signage, ghost signage and historic neon signage) Removal of inappropriate or out-of- date signage
- 2. Awnings repair or installation of awnings of materials and design in keeping with the character of the District.
- 3. Rehabilitation or compatible reconstruction of storefronts
- 4. Removing non-historic elements from building facades, i.e. metal and vinyl siding and exterior slip covers (surfaces) such as wooden shingles.
- 5. Exterior cleaning, painting and/or paint removal
- 6. Masonry repair and repainting, removal of paint over original brick, restoration of original brick
- 7. Repair and replacement of architectural details or materials
- 8. Window repair or in certain cases replacement
- 9. Restoration or replacement of deteriorated or hazardous sidewalks
- 10. Improvements to back or side street customer entrances of buildings in certain circumstances. are
