KEEP MILES CITY BEAUTIFUL GREAT AMERICAN CLEANUP

May 13-14, 2016



- *You can take your garbage to the Miles City Landfill on Friday and Saturday. There will be **NO** assistance unloading!
- * The City will no longer be picking up garbage at homes

Residents can take their own materials to the landfill on Friday, May 13th or Saturday, May 14th. The Landfill hours are 8:30am-5:30pm. **NO ASBESTOS RELATED MATERIALS ARE ALLOWED AT ANY TIME!**

Materials accepted, at no charge, at the landfill, on Friday May 13th and Saturday May 14th are as follows:

- Household garbage
- Yard waste, trees, and compost
- Metal, aluminum, residential refrigerators (remove doors if possible)
- Concrete

A \$10 fee will apply to the following items:

- Air conditioners
- Soda machines
- Commercial refrigerators, freezers, and all other Freon units

Fees for tires, depending on their size, will range from \$1.50 to \$22.50. A higher fee will be assessed if rims are still attached.

Groups or individuals can get information at the Miles City Chamber of Commerce during their office hours of 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 pm, or at Riverside Park on Saturday, May 14th from 9:00am to 12:00pm. You will be able to select a location from the list of critical areas that have been identified.

Trash bags and gloves will be provided at the Park signup for groups participating in the Saturday clean up. Most people will clean up on Saturday, but you can clean up an area anytime during the week. Please, keep in mind that free disposal at the landfill will only be Friday and Saturday. Miles City Recycling options, as well as safety brochures, will also be available at the signup. They are also available at www.milescitychamber.com and at the Miles City Chamber office.

All residents in Miles City are encouraged to participate by beautifying their own property, including keeping weeds trimmed. We also ask that you provide assistance to anyone unable to clean their own yard.

Additional information:

- *Last year, in Miles City, over 130 volunteers contributed approximately 225 hours to clean up our community, haul items to the landfill, and to recycle materials, during our May Cleanup Event. Volunteers, from 17 participating groups and City trucks, took over 5,000 pounds of debris to the landfill, recycled 325 pounds, trees were trimmed and 21 planters were filled for the downtown Spring is the best time to clean up, before the grass and weeds have a chance to hide trash and make retrieval difficult. Eliminating trashy areas reduces other unwelcome behavior. Fortunately, the reverse is also true – Clean Communities tend to stay cleaner.*
- *KMCB has already found the trash collected, in some areas, has decreased with regular maintenance. According to Keep America Beautiful research, a community, which ensures consistent and ongoing clean-up efforts, also sees a decrease in the amounts of contributed litter, thus driving down the costs of dealing with debris. The indirect costs of litter include the loss to businesses, based on the amount of trash deters customers from entering; keeping a new employer from locating in a community; and the reduction of real estate values. The presence of litter in a community actually decreases property values by 7%, according to the National Association of Home Builders pricing model.*
- *The thousands of community Great American Cleanup events orchestrated each year are often the first volunteerism exposure that children and families experience. It can be the spark to continue volunteer service into their future.*

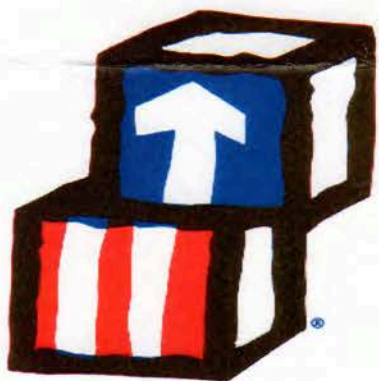

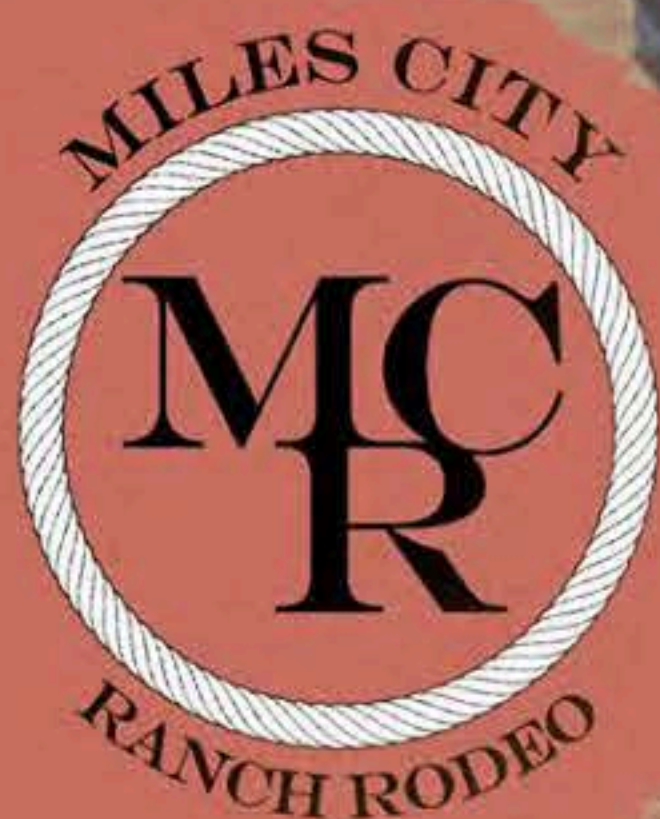
