- VSO can help with the initial application and/or annual "Means Test" for access to the VA Montana Healthcare Systems.
- VSO helps with continuing education and assistance for the general public, governmental agencies and elected officials regarding veterans' services, programs, initiatives and policy.
- VSO can also help a Veteran add this designation to their Driver's License or State ID Card. In order for this to be accomplished, I will need to see an original or certified copy of the Veterans DD-214.
