Participants are expected to attend all lessons.



Control Techniques for Prairie Dogs & Pocket Gophers: Stephen Vantassel, Department of Agriculture's Vertebrate Pest Specialist Vantassel, will be presenting information on the control of prairie dogs and pocket gophers. His presentation will review basic life history, damage identification and impacts, and cover the pros and cons of control techniques on the market today. 


