Citizen/Business Alert 11/28/17

Local law enforcement has investigated two incidents involving counterfeit \$100 bills.

Citizens and businesses are urged to take precautions when accepting \$100 bills as payment. The counterfeit bills appear to have some sort of foreign writing on them and they have been used all over the United States. Some of the counterfeit bills have been sold on-line as prop money.

Under federal law, possessing counterfeit currency or the use or attempted use of counterfeit currency is illegal if the person has the intent to defraud the recipient. Convictions carry up to 20 years in prison and a fine.

Citizens and businesses encountering the counterfeit bills are urged to contact local law enforcement immediately. The bills should be seized immediately and turned over to local law enforcement. The bills will then be turned over to the United States Secret Service for further investigation.

On June 14, 2017, Phoenix was diagnosed in utero with Tetralogy of Fallot, a rare condition caused by a combination of four heart defects that are present at birth (congenital).

Ashten moved to Denver, Colorado one month prior to Phoenix being born. Phoenix was born on 10/23/17 and endured her first open heart surgery at 3 days old to replace the pulmonary valve (pulmonary atresia) that did not form during fetal growth and patched a ventricular septal defect, a hole in the wall (septum) that separates the two lower chambers of the heart.

Phoenix is recovering and making good progress but still has a long road ahead of her and she will need additional surgeries which are not predictable.





- ✓ Families with children will NOT have an application to fill out in advance this year! (paperwork will be filled out upon check-in at the event)
- ✓ We will be running the program as a shopping day on **December 9th from 10 am – 2 pm in the old Texas Club building (716 Main St.)** Parents will be able to choose from a variety of items for their kids and a wrapping station will be available if you wish to use it afterwards!
- ✓ Join our event on the Miles City Empty Stockings Facebook page to receive reminders!
- ✓ It is up to you if you bring your kids with you—if you do, that means they will be picking out gifts with you, so they’ll know what they’ll be getting for Christmas.
- ✓ There will be an annual household income cap based on family size (see income eligibility chart below. Applicants must bring a copy of their 2016 Tax Return (not W-2’s) for proof of income and household size. We will not keep the copy.
- ✓ If you do not file taxes due to disability or social security income, please bring one other document for proof of public assistance, Section 8 housing, WIC, or food stamps.
- ✓ If you do not meet the income requirements, but have faced an unforeseen hardship or your income situation has changed since filing taxes, please provide an explanation or additional documentation (such as most recent paystub) at check-in.
- ✓ We will not allow “subs” to come pick out gifts for another family’s kids.
