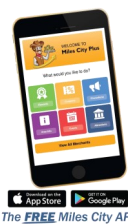

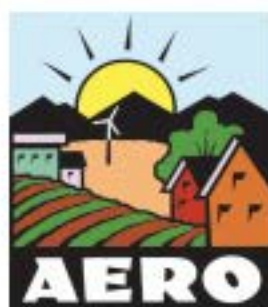

Erin Becker is a single mom with an amazing son. She was diagnosed with osteogenic sarcoma at the age of five. Over the past 27 years, Erin has undergone 40+ surgeries, one being an above the knee amputation at the age of 24.

Erin requires extensive and very specialized surgeries with a team of top surgeons in Minneapolis, where she has been getting treatment since the initial cancer. Her case is so rare that all 3 surgeons on her medical team have decided to do the crucial surgeries pro-bono; however, the hospital will not accept her insurance to cover the remainder of the fees. Expenses incurred for these surgeries will be extremely large and she will not be able to schedule the procedures until she can prove she is able to pay for the hospital stays (at least 2 weeks each), anesthesia, etc. There is also travel expenses to consider.

Our goal is to help defray the cost so Erin can put all her energies into healing without the stress of insurmountable medical debt. All monies donated will go to exactly that. Thank you in advance for your love and support.

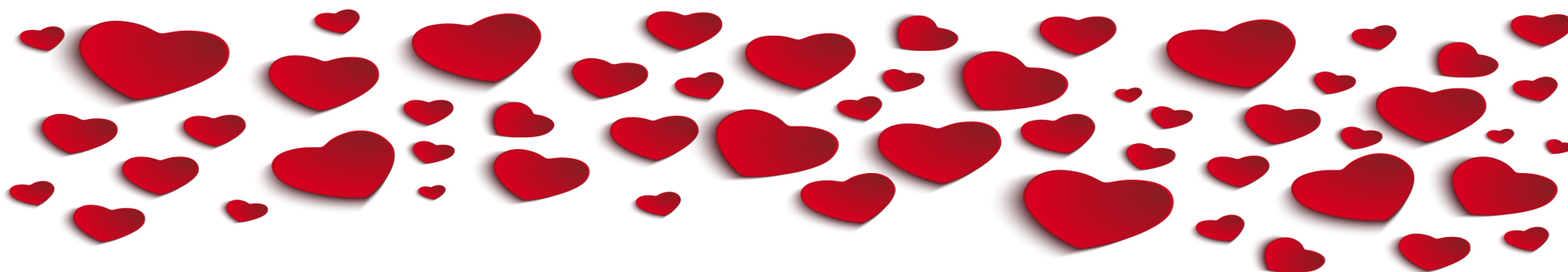
