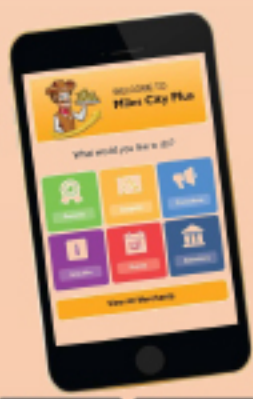

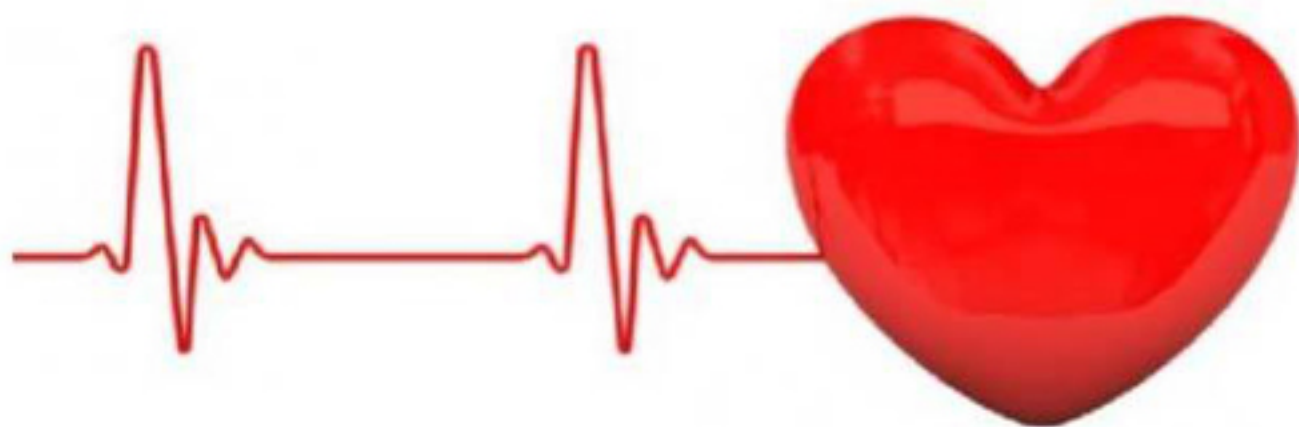

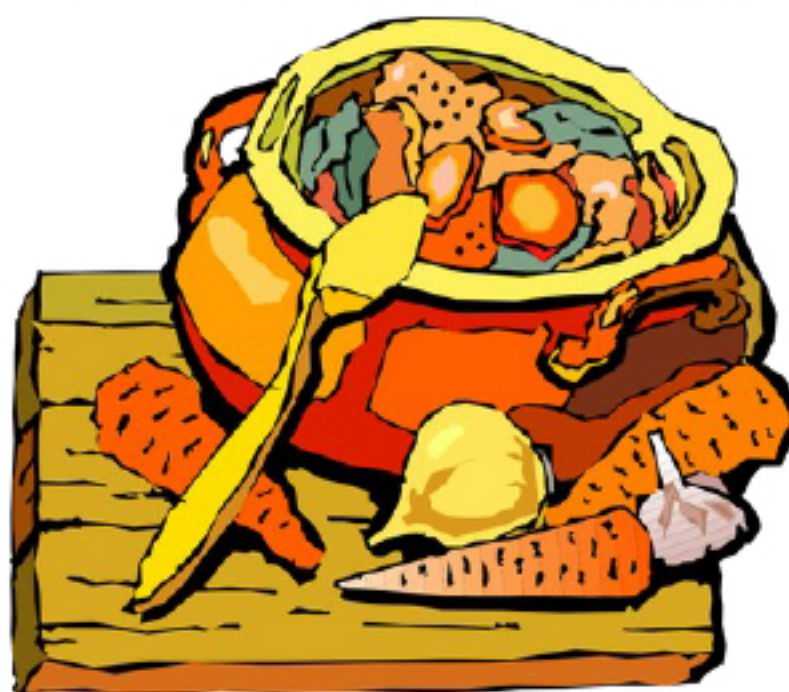

Dear Colleague,

Thank you for taking time out of your busy schedule to give this your attention. As you may be aware from earlier communications, Miles City will be the site of the 4th Annual Nonprofit "Kaleidoscope" Conference, June 14 at the Sleep Inn. It is brought to us by the Montana Nonprofit Association (MNA) and especially designed to meet the needs of eastern Montana's nonprofit staffs, volunteers, and board members. (See attached flier and website: www.mtnonprofit.org.)

With the cutbacks while needs continue, the Nonprofit Kaleidoscope Conference is particularly timely and convenient. In consideration of funding challenges, there will be sessions on fund raising, as well as managing for excellence. In addition, there will be sessions for board members throughout the whole day, with a special two-part session after lunch as a convenience for board members available only for the half day. Tax-exempt government entities, like libraries, social service agencies, schools, etc., are also included in the target audience.

To further accommodate financial constraints, MNA collapsed the conference from 1 ½ days to 1 day. Registration fees were cut with generous **discounts for early bird registration through June 5**, plus discounts for members. All are invited to become members, which is on a sliding scale and would be offset by the discounts.

The Kaleidoscope Conference offers practical opportunities right here in Miles City June 14 for networking and training to benefit local nonprofits and their work for our community. Appreciation goes to MNA for continuing to reach out to eastern Montana with this regional conference to meet our needs and travel limitations.

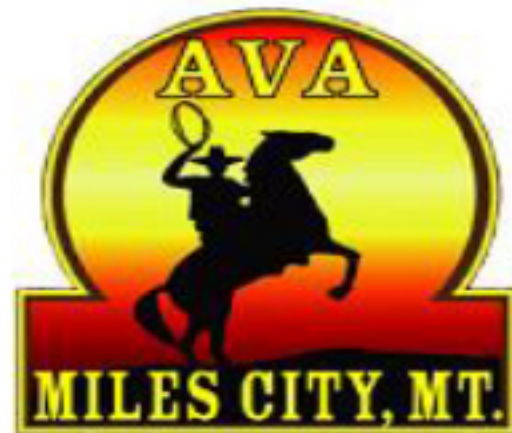

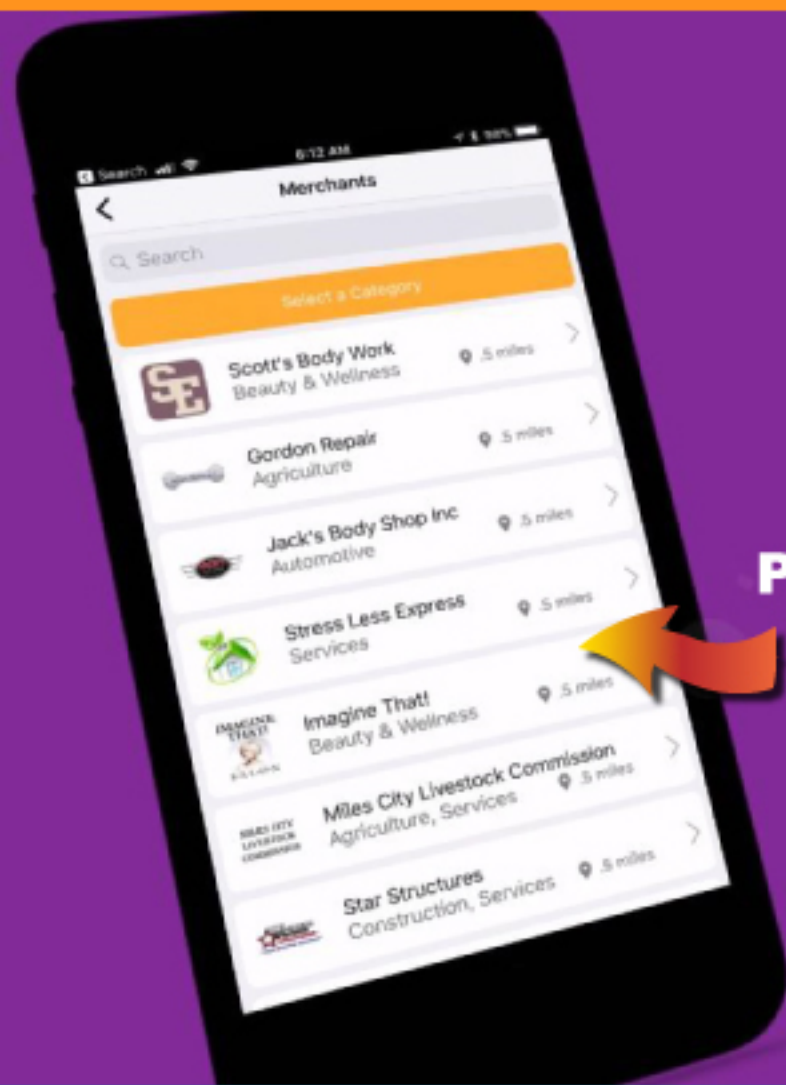
