HiSET Testing Fees Increase in 2019

The five separate HiSET subtests will increase from \$10 to \$15 each on January 2, 2019. The proctor fee of \$3 per test will not increase. The subtest cost includes two free retests if needed. Those who have paid for but not yet taken HiSET tests in 2018 will not have to pay the difference; however, test fees expire after one year. For other HiSET information, visit www.hiset.ets.org.
