Why

Many agricultural producers continually seek ways in which to achieve a higher dollar return and expanded customer base for their commodities by producing value-added products. USDA will make available up to \$32 million nationwide to farmers, ranchers, and businesses to develop new value-added products and expand markets.

Generating new products, creating and expanding marketing opportunities, and increasing producer income are the goals of USDA's Value Added Producer Grant Program. These grants support planning activities, such as developing a business plan, as well as provide working capital to implement viable value-added business plans.

The maximum grant amount for planning grants is \$75,000 while the maximum amount for working capital grants is \$250,000.
