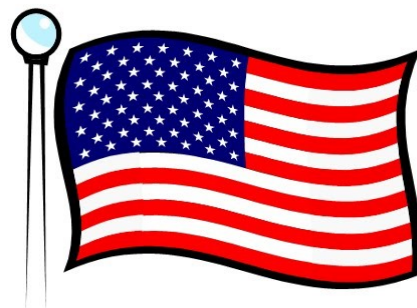

2019 Ordinances Discharging Fireworks Inside City Limits



Miles City, Montana

The discharge of fireworks shall be allowed at these locations:

- Bender Park
- Riverside Park
- Jaycee Field
- Tedesco Field

On these days and times:

- Wednesday, July 3rd: 10:00am—10:00 pm
- Thursday, July 4th: 10:00am—12:00am
 - **On July 4th—No Fireworks allowed in Riverside Park after 8:00pm*
- Friday, July 5th: 10:00am—10:00am

On July 4th, NO fireworks are allowed after 8:00 pm at Riverside Park.

Non-aerial fireworks, being those fireworks which do not project themselves into the air, or fire projectiles into the air, shall be allowed within the city limits on Thursday July 4th but not any other day except those days and places listed above.

The discharge of fireworks within the city limits, or upon any property of the City of Miles City, on any other dates, at any other times or locations is prohibited, and shall be enforced by the Miles City Police Department.

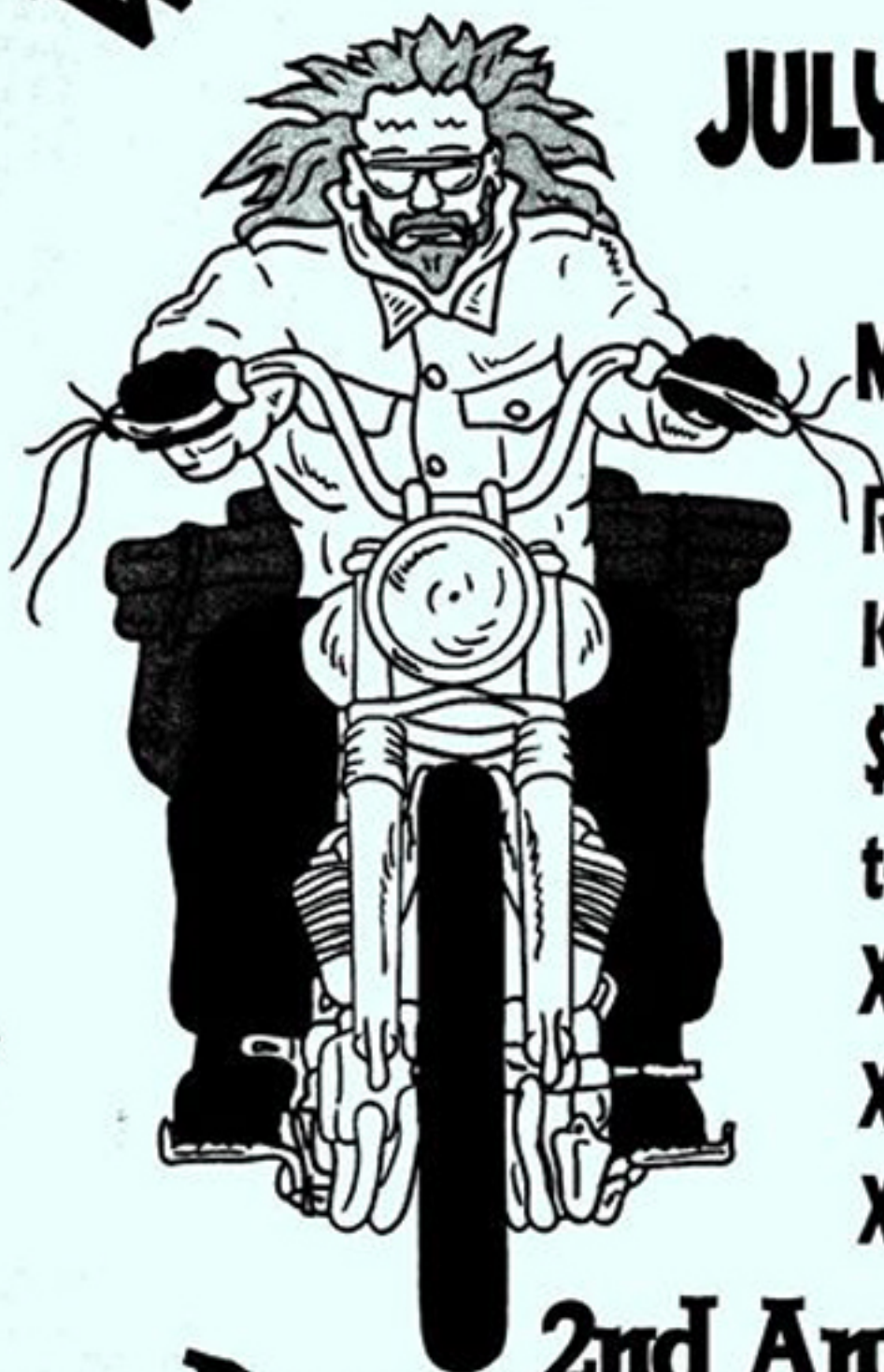

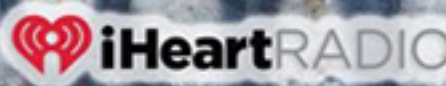
