In early, 2017, Murray was diagnosed with Smoldering Multiple Myeloma, a precancerous form of myeloma, a cancer of plasma cells in the bone marrow. In March 2019 the cancer was confirmed active.

Murray and Tana moved to Seattle, Washington on September 22, 2019 and are currently completing a series of tests. Murray will soon begin a process involving a Stem Cell Transplant, this process will take 2 months or longer.

After consults with the doctors, Murray and Tana learned that there is no cure but hope for remission which can be short term or as long as 8 to 10 years. The hope within this time frame there has been enough research done for a "cure".
