## ROUNDABOUT LANDSCAPING/ STATUE PROJECT

HISTORY IN THE MAKING





#### THE MISSION

The 2017 graduating class of Miles City Area Economic Development Council's (MCAEDC) Leadership Miles City pursued an exciting group project that allowed them to assist in the landscaping of the future Broadus Interchange. Montana Department of Transportation reached out to the group with the opportunity to design features of the landscaping for the upcoming road project, which included adding two roundabouts to the intersections of HWY 59 and Interstate 94, on the south end of Haynes Avenue in Miles City.

With the help of MCAEDC and several local sponsors to begin funding on the project, the class made a proposal to local artist and Miles City business owner Erin Thormodsgard, to create a large rearing horse welded out of scrap metal. This statue will be placed in the center of the smaller roundabout, located north of the interstate. The group also planned

for large faux rocks, featuring metal welcome signs and the "MC" brand welded by another local business, to be placed on the southern roundabout, All detailed plans were submitted and approved by MT-DOT,

Fundraising for the project continues to draw in donations from around the area. Business owners and private citizens alike are excited to bring such a unique feature to the high traffic area. An estimated \$8,000 is needed in order to complete the project, slated to wrap up in November 2020. (See timeline on back for details.) Construction on the horse began in 2018, and rock and shrubbery options were selected and ordered. Projected costs must be funded fully in order to complete the scheduled design.

With the help of these donors and future sponsors, the new and improved intersection will be a welcomed and attractive view as travelers and residents arrive in Miles City.
