5 FACTS ABOUT VETERANS DAY

1 No apostrophe.

A lot of people believe it is "Veteran's Day" or "Veterans' Day," but that is incorrect. The holiday is not a day that "belongs" to one veteran or multiple veterans, which is what an apostrophe implies. It's a day for honoring **all veterans** — so no apostrophe is not applied.



2 Not The Same As Memorial Day.

Memorial Day is the time to remember those who sacrificed their lives in battle or who suffered wounds in battle. Veterans Day honors all those who served (war or peace, dead or alive- it is most to **thank living veterans** for their sacrifice.)


3 Originally Armistice Day.

Fighting did not officially end until the Allies & Germany put an armistice into effect on the **11th hour of 11th day of the 11th month**. This was why Nov. 11, 1918, was largely considered the end of the war, Armistice Day. It was later changed after the World War II and the Korean War yet again, by changing "armistice" to "veterans." That way it can honor all American veterans of all wars.



4 Changing Dates.

On Oct. 25, 1971, a new bill was passed that Veterans Day was to be commemorated for the fourth Monday of every October. Many citizens were confused about the change and wanted to celebrate Veterans Day on Nov. 11, since it was a matter of **historic and patriotic significance**.



5 Celebrated In Other Countries.

Since World War I is a multinational effort, our allies also celebrate their Veterans on Nov. 11. In Canada, Australia and Great Britain they call their holiday "Remembrance Day." For both Canada and Australia, they honor their deceased veterans by wearing a red poppy flower. In Australia, the day is more similar to our Memorial Day. For Great Britain, they observe the Sunday closest to Nov. 11 with parades, services and 2 minute of silence in London to honor their deceased.



Resident Recruitment in Rural America: Capitalizing on COVID-19 Influx of New Talent into Montana

Ben Winchester has been working both in and for small towns across the Midwest for over 25 years. He lives in St. Cloud, Minnesota with his wife and two children. Ben is trained as a Rural Sociologist and works as a Senior Research Fellow for the University of Minnesota Extension. His applied research on economic, social, and demographic topics surrounding the theme of "rewriting the rural narrative" is a new way of looking at rural America. Winchester received his B.A. in Mathematics and Statistics from the University of Minnesota, Morris (1995), and M.S. in Rural Sociology from the University of Missouri, Columbia (2001). He was a founding employee at the Center for Small Towns, an outreach and engagement program at the University of Minnesota, Morris and specializes in community development, demographic analysis, data visualization, and moving communities away from anecdotal.
