


June 25 & 26, 2021 COWTOWN COOKOFF RULES & GUIDELINES

1. This event is sponsored by the Custer County Community Table, a 501 (c3) non-profit organization, referred to as the Miles City Soup Kitchen. Rules and times are subject to change, and in that event, contestants will be properly notified.
2. This event will adhere to the KCBS Rules and Regulations except those exceptions or additions listed in this document. The decision and interpretation of the KCBS Rules & Regulations are at the discretion of the KCBS Contest Representative assigned to the event.
3. A team will consist of one chief cook and all the assistants deemed necessary by the chief cook.
4. Each team will be assigned a cooking space, and all equipment and/or supplies must fit within that space. Contestant set-up is Friday June 25 (you may arrive Thursday June 24 as well) until 10:00 pm. Quiet hours are from 10:00 pm Friday - 6:00 am Saturday at which time event security will be present. Other necessary streets will be closed to through-traffic early Friday morning, and only those involved with the event will be allowed to drive within that area. If a contestant plans to arrive prior to street closure, or leave directly after judging, a space will be assigned to allow for a safe set-up/exit; however, Event Organizer must be informed so that proper assignments can be made.
5. Contestants shall provide all needed equipment, supplies, utensils, extension cords, tables, chairs, and a fire extinguisher. The Event will provide electricity; however, access to electricity may be limited and therefore quiet generators will be allowed but must be pre-approved by the Event Organizers. The Event will provide up to 40 lbs of ice to each team, and will make every effort to have additional ice available for a reasonable fee.
6. A Cook's meeting will be held on Friday at 5:00 pm in the Quad K building.



7. All samples must be turned into judges by the posted turn-in time schedule as follows:

Chicken 12:00am-- Pork Ribs 12:30pm-- Pork 1:00pm-- Brisket 1:30pm

8. The Event Organizers respectfully requests any left-over meat after judging be donated to the CCCT to be used as taste samplers, at which time all proceeds from those samples will go to the CCCT. All donations are tax deductible, so the CCCT encourages contestants to cook a little extra for the charity.

9. The Event Organizers will make every effort to accommodate every team with ample space; however, sidewalks must not be blocked during the event. Any extension cords ran must not pose a tripping hazard to the general public.

10. The Event Organizers will not be responsible to the contestant for any loss or damages caused as a result of an unattended space during the event.
