EXECUTIVE ORDER 2021-01

CITY OF MILES CITY – OFFICE OF THE MAYOR

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER PERTAINING TO THE DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS
WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MILES CITY OVER THE
INDEPENDENCE DAY HOLIDAY, 2021**

WHEREAS, As the result of extremely dry conditions and unusually high fire risk, the City of Miles City has determined that it is necessary to restrict the use of fireworks during the 2021 Independence Day “Fourth of July” holiday, to ensure the safety of the City’s residents as well as property located within the City of Miles City;

AND WHEREAS, on June 29, 2021, a grass and wildland fire was started by fireworks within the City of Miles City in a wilderness area known as the “Honda Trails,” further evidencing the need to restrict the use of fireworks during the 2021 Independence Day holiday weekend;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority conferred by Montana Code Annotated Section 7-33-4206, the City Council has the authority to restrict the use of fireworks within its jurisdiction;


AND WHEREAS, the City Council has enacted an ordinance, codified as Section 16-48 of the Code of Ordinances of Miles City, Montana, granting authority to the Mayor to prohibit the use of fireworks by executive order;

**NOW THEREFORE, AS THE MAYOR OF MILES CITY, MONTANA, I ISSUE
THE FOLLOWING EXECUTIVE ORDER:**


1. That for the protection of the residents and property within the City of Miles City, the discharge of fireworks within the city limits of the City of Miles City shall be prohibited during the 2021 Independence Day holiday weekend. City Code Section 16-48 generally allows for the discharge of certain fireworks within the city limits between July 3 and July 5 of each year, and such allowance for the year 2021 is hereby rescinded.

2. That the commercial display of fireworks by the local VFW shall not be subject to this order, and the Miles City Fire Department is hereby directed to provide fire protection and prevention assistance to the VFW for said fireworks display. The Miles City Fire Chief or his designee shall have the authority to restrict or terminate said fireworks display at any time should safety concerns arise.

SO ORDERED this 30th day of June, 2021 at 7:00 P.M.
