
Eastern Montana Community Mental Health Center Awarded Suicide Prevention Grant 500 in 17 to commence September 1, 2021

Eastern Montana Community Mental Health Center (EMCMHC) has received a \$5,532 Suicide Prevention Services grant from the State of Montana, Department of Health and Human Services. With these funds, EMCMHC will initiate the **500 in 17** project, designed to train and certify 500 QPR (Question. Persuade. Refer) community Gatekeepers in EMCMHC's 17 county service area.

QPR is an evidenced based program that is designed to increase suicide awareness, increase the skillset for people to effectively assist individuals in behavioral health crisis and those individuals at risk for suicide, and provides Gatekeepers with resources and referral protocol for individuals in crisis and at risk for suicide.

"We recognize that our service region has been hit hard by drought, fires, agricultural losses and Covid. Eastern Montana's strongest resource has always been its people and this is what **500 in 17** draws upon, neighbors taking care of each other", said Brenda Kneeland, CEO at EMCMHC.

500 in 17 will kick-off in conjunction with National Suicide Awareness month, on September 1, 2021 and conclude by December 31, 2021. Training announcements and schedules will be posted on EMCMHC's Facebook page, as well as advertised locally in each community hosting a training.
