This has been an exciting year after being closed for the 2020 season. Listed below is a summary of some of the 2021 Range Riders Museum activities. A BIG THANK YOU TO ALL WHO SUPPORTED THE MUSEUM THROUGH MEMBERSHIPS, DONATIONS, ENTRY FEES, GIFT SHOP PURCHASES, AND FUNDRAISERS.

In 2021, we:

- Assisted many researchers, from individuals writing books to families researching history;
- Hosted many tours, including school tours from Custer, Lame Deer and Miles City with a total of 153 guests, private tours for groups from Leadership of Montana, Teen Tour, FFA Officers, a mental health organization, a busload of visitors from Agrocrors, and one all-day tour with assisted research for a man from New Jersey;
- Renovated and added exhibits to the Fort Keogh Officers' Quarters. We received a grant from The Nibs and Edna Allen Foundation that allowed us to complete the renovations on the inside. The Chad Cyrus Taxidermy display has been placed in the East side and work is underway to display hundreds of pictures in another room;
- Repaired the parking lot and put a new roof on the Clark Gun Building. Another grant from the Allen Foundation allowed us to complete this work;
- Renovated the outside of the original museum log building, built in 1942. Other grants allowed us to hire contractors to sand blast, chink, stain, and resurface the exterior log walls. Not a single log had to be replaced;
- Hosted the Bucking Horse Sale Breakfast, which was a huge success and included a book signing. Gary
  Haughian's team pulled the grain wagon in the parade and won 1st place in their division;
- Loaned the Iron Lung to the Billings Western Heritage Center for a "Conquering Diseases of the Past" display;
- Had many photographers use the museum buildings and exhibits for their photo shoots;
- Received many donated artifacts to help tell the history of our area. A special gift was a bronze replica of a In 2022, scheduled work includes:
