Beef Production Strategies to Optimize the Use of Low-Quality Feedstuffs

Samples may include herbicide damage, insect/pest ID, plant diseases, plant ID, and weed ID. This presentation will also cover how to properly sample harvested and standing forages, soil, and water for local Extension office testing, as well as for commercial laboratory analyses.




