What Does it Take to Pass the High School Equivalency Test (HSET)?

The HiSET® exam is rigorous and requires a lot of preparation and study! The HiSET passing standards are set at such a high level that over 30 percent of all traditional high school graduates would not pass the five subject tests on their first try. HiSET is recognized as the equivalent of a high school diploma, and it opens all the same doors to employment, college, and the military.

Passing your HiSET exam is a significant achievement and demonstrates that you have attained the skills and knowledge equivalent to those of a traditional high school graduate in these five areas: Reading, Writing, Science, Social Studies, and Mathematics. To pass each individual HiSET subject test, you need to attain a score that would place you among the top 40 percent of all graduating high school seniors!

Each of the five HiSET subtests includes between 50 and 60 questions, and the whole battery takes about 7 ½ hours to complete. The Writing test not only has 60 questions on editing skills, but also requires you to read two opposing viewpoint essays and write your own opinion essay in response. You must know algebra to pass the math test, as 45% of the questions involve algebra word problems. Social Studies covers history, government, economics, and geography. For science, you must know life science, chemistry, physics, and earth science. Reading tests you with excerpts from fiction as well as on business documents and other non-fiction pieces.
