





Dear Montana Business Owner:

With the passage of Initiative 190, marijuana use is now prohibited in all enclosed public places and workplaces, including work vehicles, or vehicles that serve as a place of work, and vehicles accessible to the public, such as taxis and buses under the Montana Clean Indoor Air Act (MCA Title 50, Chapter 40). The definition of "smoking" or "to smoke" under MCA 50-40-103 now includes, "the act of lighting, smoking, or carrying a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, or any smokable product and includes the use of marijuana."

Under MCA 50-40-104, the Montana Clean Indoor Air Act requires the proprietor or manager of an establishment containing enclosed public places to post a sign in a conspicuous place at all public entrances to the establishment stating, in a manner that can be easily read and understood, that smoking in the enclosed public place is prohibited.

Included with this letter is signage that clearly communicates to patrons, employees and others who may enter your place of business the prohibition of marijuana smoking under Montana law.

Should you require additional signage, please visit tobaccofree.mt.gov and click "Online Store" for free signs that can be shipped directly to your business.
