Have you heard of "Growth Mindset?"

Many of our students arrive at the Learning Center with "gaps" in their education-- areas which, through no fault of their own, they missed during their school years. The prospect of learning these new subjects can be daunting.

That's where "growth mindset" comes in. At the Learning Center, staff encourages people to add the word "yet" when talking about their learning gaps. For instance, if a student comes in and says, "I can't do algebra," we encourage them to say, "I can't do algebra...yet."

It sounds like a small adjustment, but words are powerful!

Adding "yet" shifts the focus from the learning gap to the

PROCESS of learning. And learning IS a process. No one walks
through our door having mastered every skill and subject area
needed to reach their academic goals.

As Center staff, we understand the discomfort that can come with learning new skills. We, too, are always encountering new study techniques we don't know how to teach to our students. We practice adding that three-letter, powerful word at the end, "... yet."




