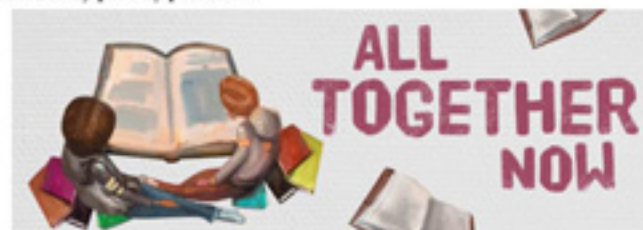

Thank you for joining our 2023 Summer Reading Program: All Together Now! Welcome all! All ages are invited to participate, but we believe kindergarten and older will enjoy it the most. Summer Reading Program (SRP) begins June 6 and ends July 13. In order to track each participant's reading achievements, children must complete Reading Logs. These can be obtained from library staff. Special events during SRP will usually be held at MCPL, but please read the details below on events held at different locations.

The Summer Reading Program is a great way to keep reading and learning a priority in your child's life. This summer our theme is Kindness, Unity, and Friendship. 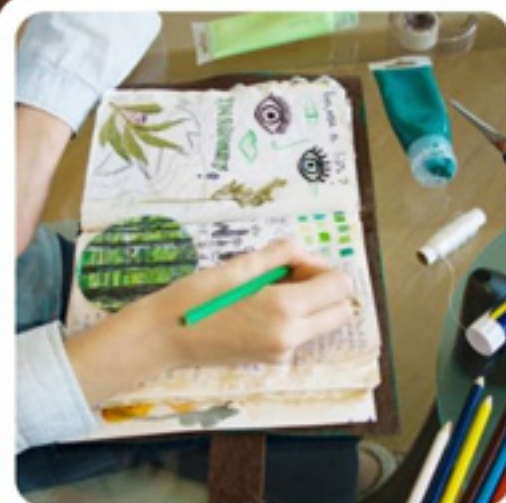

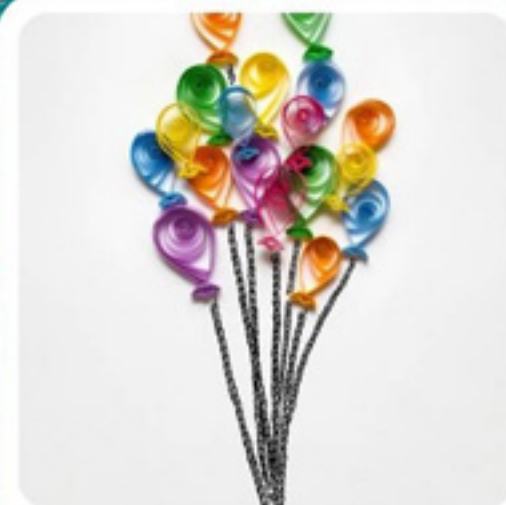

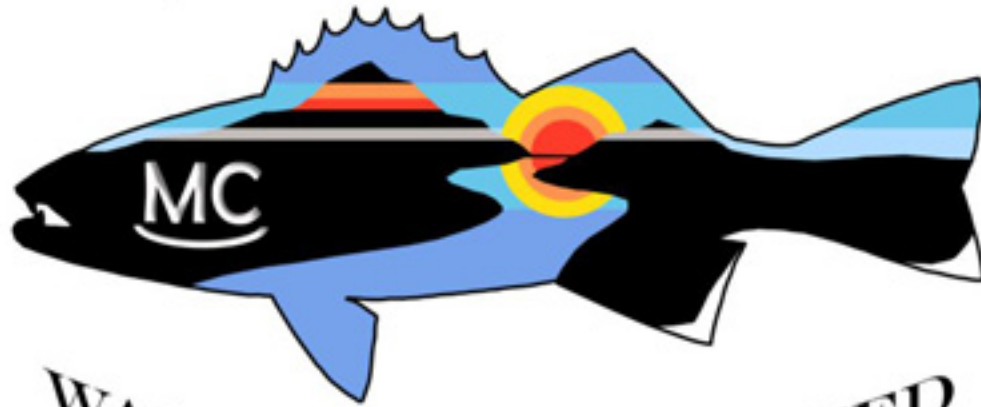
