ORDINANCE NO. 1313

AN ORDINANCE REVISING SECTION 16-48 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MILES CITY, MONTANA, SO AS REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING THE USE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Miles City, Montana, as follows:

Section 1. Section 16-48 shall be amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 16-48. - Fireworks.

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge or cause to be discharged any fireworks, as defined by state law, within the city limits; provided that the city council may grant a permit for a supervised public display of fireworks to be held by the city, fair association, amusement park or other organizations or groups of individuals. The city council, by resolution, may allow the discharge of fireworks at special times and places as deemed appropriate as long as such use is in accordance with state law and any other reasonable restrictions which the council may impose in order to preserve the public peace and safety. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the discharge of fireworks shall be allowed between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on July 3rd; between 10:00 a.m. and midnight on July 4th; and between 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. July 5th; at the following locations within the City of Miles City, to-wit: Bender Park, Riverside Park, Jaycee Field, Tedesco Field. Furthermore, non-aerial fireworks, which are those fireworks which do not project themselves into the air, or fire projectiles into the air, shall be generally allowed within the City limits on July 4th of each year, but shall not be allowed on any other day except as herein before set forth. The foregoing allowances may be altered or suspended by Resolution of the City Council, or by Executive Order of the Mayor.





Student Numbers Increase


This past program year, the Learning Center saw a large increase in their adult student traffic.





INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX REBATE



How much is the rebate?

The rebate amount depends on an individual's 2021 tax filing status and the amount reported on line 20 of their 2021 Montana Individual Income Tax Return (Form 2).

- ✓ If you filed married filing jointly, the rebate is \$2,500 or the amount reported on line 20, whichever is less
- If you filed single, head of household, or married filing separately, the rebate is \$1,250 or the amount reported on line 20, whichever is less

What are the qualifications?

To qualify for the rebate, you must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ You filed a 2021 Montana resident tax return by October 17, 2022
- ✓ You filed a 2020 Montana resident or part-year resident tax return by October 17, 2022
- ✓ Line 20 of your 2021 Montana tax return has an amount greater than zero
- You weren't claimed as a dependent on another taxpayer's 2021 tax return
- ✓ For rebate consideration, amended 2021 returns must have been filed by May 1, 2023

When and how will I receive my rebate?

The Montana Department of Revenue will begin issuing rebates to eligible taxpayers in July 2023. All rebates will be issued by December 31, 2023, using the banking information provided on your most recently filed Montana Form 2.

Beginning June 15, 2023, you may check your rebate eligibility and amount by visiting our TransAction Portal (tap.dor.mt.gov) and clicking on "Where's My Rebate?"

MONTANA PROPERTY TAX REBATE



What is the Property Tax Rebate?

The Property Tax Rebate is a rebate of up to \$675 a year of property taxes paid on a principal residence. There is a rebate available for property taxes paid for the 2022 tax year and another rebate available for property taxes paid for the 2023 tax year.

What are the qualifications?

To qualify for the property tax rebate you must have:

- owned a Montana residence for at least seven months,
- lived in this Montana residence for at least seven months,
- had property taxes billed on this residence, and
- paid those property taxes on this residence.

How do I claim a property tax rebate?

Taxpayers may claim the 2022 rebate online through our TransAction Portal (tap.dor.mt.gov) or by paper form beginning August 15, 2023. The 2022 claim must be filed by October 1, 2023. We will begin accepting claims for the 2023 rebate on August 15, 2024. The 2023 claim must be filed by October 1, 2024.
