



What is Communities That Care? CTC, as it's often referred to, is a framework for building a coalition and helping that coalition approach local issues. It is proven to work. Studies have shown that, among other outcomes, youth in CTC communities are:

- 32% less likely to start drinking alcohol
- 37% less likely to "binge" drink.*

CTC is based on prevention science. What does that mean? It's all about working upstream of problems rather than reacting to them when they occur. The idea is to promote positive development before young people become involved in problem behaviors. This is done through the application of tested and effective policies, programs, and practices that are specifically based on the data that comes from the Montana Prevention Needs Assessment taken by our students.
